## Scope of Services

Provide a fee proposal to review construction costs for accuracy and reasonableness for demolition and reconstruction of an existing downtown structure to include:

- 1. Demolition of existing structure (712 W. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Anchorage) to include removal of foundation system (except east wall as noted in civil narrative), utilities and site improvements.
- 2. Selective demolition of existing 45,623 sqft, 6-story and basement structure (716 W. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Anchorage), interior, exterior, and roof system to include all non-structural interior walls, ceilings, flooring, lighting, entire HVAC system, entire plumbing system, entire electrical system, entire data/comm wiring, restroom fixtures, fire sprinkler systems, fire alarm systems, existing windows, exterior cladding, and exterior entry & parking access doors. Both structures are presumed to contain potentially hazardous materials.
- 3. Reconstruction of remaining high-rise structure to include structural steel/seismic bracing, exterior glazed curtain walls, decorative cladding, new roof, new HVAC system, new plumbing system, new electrical system, new data/comm systems, new fire sprinkler system, new fire alarm system, new main entrance, and complete interior finishes for core & shell and tenant improvements for a modest, professional, business-like appearance.
- 4. Construct a new service tower and two-story structure on site of previously demolished structure (712 W. 4th) to include 2 new elevators, security office, public restrooms, new service entrance with elevator, conference rooms, loading dock, emergency generator, and complete interior finishes to match the newly reconstructed adjoining structure.
- 5. Documents to be reviewed under this amendment include the proposed construction cost estimate, design/build drawings and narratives. Site visits may be required to confirm conditions affecting construction, staging area, street closures, and other assumptions needed for pricing a design/build GMP stage construction project.
- 6. All wage rates for the project are to be based on State of Alaska Title 36 "Little Davis-Bacon" wage rates for public projects.
- 7. Deliverables for this task is to be a brief report of findings and determination if the proposed construction costs fall within an acceptable range for this type and scale of construction/redevelopment of the buildings and site identified by this scope. Include a brief narrative regarding the methodology used to review the costs, and attach a copy of the credentials and experience of the individual/persons performing the review.
